Frame

- > front feet in steel tube ø22x1.5 mm / seat support ø18x1.2 mm / rear feet in steel tube ø13x1 mm / seat in beech plywood 7.5 mm
- > Black epoxy paint:

- > anti-slip and anti-scratch rubber pads

Flight case for 20 LILA® I folding chairs :

- > Top lid hinged
- > 2 large recessed butterfly latches with guided opening/closing mechanism (1 with padlock brackets)
- > 10 recessed flip handles with double sprung
- > 4 swivel castors Ø100 (2 with brake) on plate
- > Cushioning foam blocks
- > Skid-proof strips in the bottom
