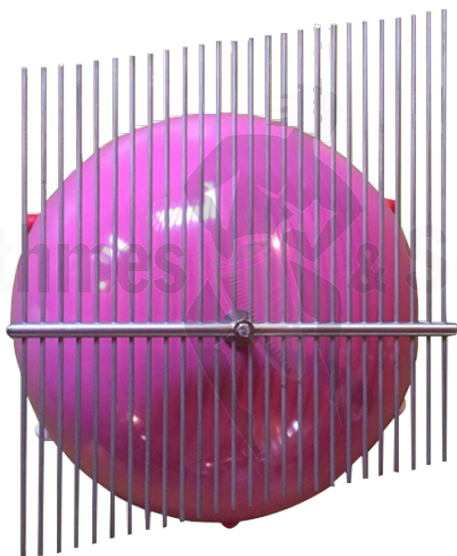

TITANIUM SOUND SOPRANO HARP MODEL LUDOPHONE

- Components: 52 bars
- Sound typology: melodious sounds and sympathetic resonance
- Factory accord: E3 to E5
- Play Modes: Friction, Percussion and Pinch
- Evolution of Marloye's metallic harps (1823) and the nail violin (circa. 1751)
- Polyphonic and monotimbral keyboard very appreciated within the framework of musical practices in specialized environments
- The small distance between the playing zones allows an exceptional response to a sound gesture of an imprecise nature
- Design based on that of an elementary geometric figure: The Rhombus

Supplied with 1 tightening key (Facom) and 2 hammers
